Summer Winter Community Garden for Executive Committee

1. New Gardeners / Wait List- all plots are taken, no one left on the wait list
2. Returning Gardeners (dues)-all dues are in
3. Work Day (Saturday April 6)- Kip will manage upcoming Work Day and Joe will use list provided to him to take attendance
4. Wood chips and Compost delivery- Ken will deliver chips. Gardeners are encouraged to use chips to do your own path. Gardeners will be advised to chip garden paths
5. West Garden Orchard update-effort underway We want to make it look like the east side orchard. Establish plan, root out volunteer trees. Dwarf apple trees will be planted there. Get rid of invasives is a priority.
6. Compost is coming next week. We need to pay them. City Harvest has not delivered compost. Phil will check on delivery. Ed will continue on chips. Gardeners will be advised to take appropriate amount. There will be more.
